- Not a previous winner of any beauty contest for the last 5 years



## **Mechanics:**

- 1. PHA member registers candidate (only one candidate each for Mr. PHA or Ms. PHA, or for both) via the online registration link --<https://forms.gle/DceJeDbzBP7wgmbi8> (Deadline July 15, 2024)**
- 2. The National Committee will screen all entries (Deadline August 30, 2024)**
- 3. Candidates that pass the initial screening will receive an email from the National Committee**
- 4. Final date and venue of screening will be announced once final.**
- 5. Awarding will be on Nov 20, 2024 during the Fellowship Night.**
